One of the goals of the annual summer Youth Mission Program offered by the Center for Mission is to help youth recognize that mission is core to their Catholic faith.

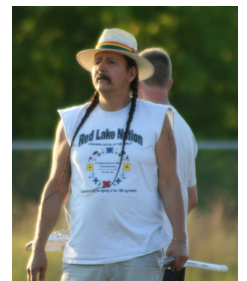
